Family Selection

Responsible for finding suitable families to receive the homes we build, reviews applications, runs credit checks, and interviews families.

Family Nurture

Provides continued support for families placed into one of our homes. When asked by the family, budgetary information, home repair help and the like will be provided.

Site Selection

Scours the county for suitable sites for building or for houses to renovate. It is responsible for negotiating prices and researching properties for liens, defects, cost of development, etc. and recommending properties to the Board of Directors.

Building

The purpose of the building construction committee is to develop the HFHPC's building plans and manage all phases of construction.

Fund Raising/Development

Raises funds for building, renovation, and for administration costs. It initiates and executes ideas for fund raisers.

Public Relations

Responsible for keeping Habitat for Humanity in the public eye. It prepares press releases, schedules the information booth for local events and publishes our newsletter.

Volunteer

Coordinates all volunteer efforts, provides new volunteers for committee openings, manages the office, ensures there are volunteers at the construction site, staffs the information booth.

Church Relations

Works with churches to establish a Covenant Church Relationship.
